**November 9, 2023**

Pet tags are \$5 for neutered/spayed  
and \$15 for intact. Proof of Vaccina-  
tion is required. Tags may be pur-  
chased at the Police Dept. M-F 9 am  
to 5pm or on the City website.



**With the upcoming change of seasons please  
remember whenever snow has accumulated  
or there is a possibility that snow will accu-  
mulate to such a depth that snow removal  
operations will be required, City Administra-  
tion may declare a traffic emergency. If this  
happens, notice will be given through local  
press, radio, and other media. During a snow  
emergency there is no parking on primary  
and secondary snow routes, which are: First
