HIGHLIGHTS FROM CITY COUNCIL

April 13, 2023

- ◆ Mayor Pralle informed the Council that water rates had not been increased since 2008 and the rates are not sufficient as the water fund is depleting. The council discussed the options and came to a consensus on the option which would have the lowest impact on those on fixed incomes. An Ordinance establishing new water rates will be presented at the next meeting.
- ◆ Four new Ordinances were unanimously passed regarding permits for buildings, parking on Black Jack road, adopting the zoning ordinance and Kansas Gas Franchise fee.
